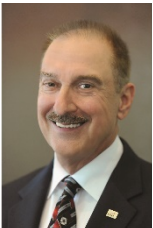

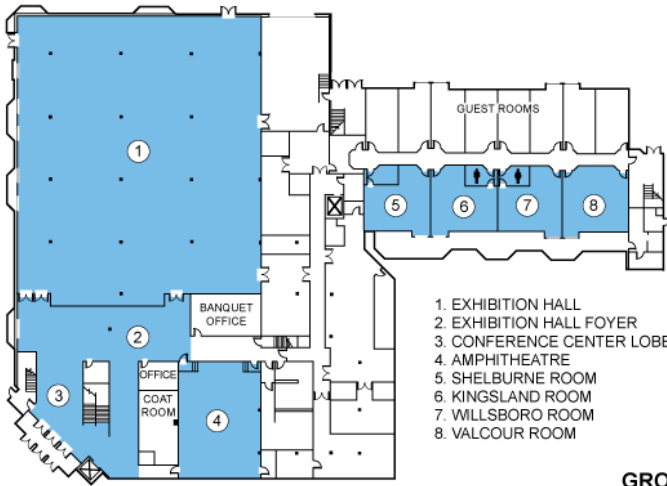

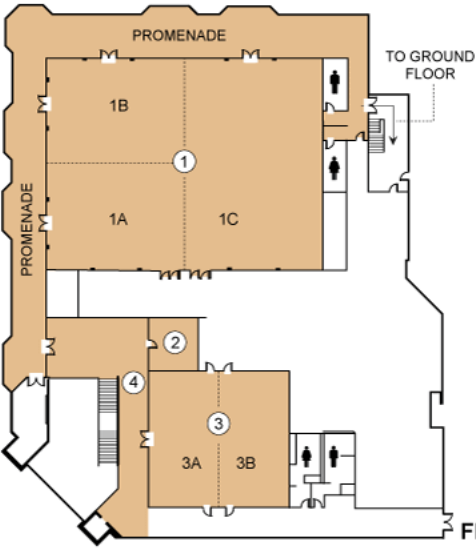
DOUBLE TREE MAP
